AN ACT CONCERNING REMEDIATION BONDS FOR GASOLINE STATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require an owner of land on
- 2 which a new gasoline station is to be built to obtain a remediation
- 3 bond prior to commencing such construction. Such requirement shall
- 4 not apply to a new gasoline station to be built on a brownfield or
- 5 property that was previously used as a gasoline station.

Statement of Purpose:

To require certain landowners to obtain a remediation bond prior to building a new gas station.
