**AN ACT CONCERNING A BIO-FUEL FEASIBILITY STUDY.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) The Commissioner of  
2 Environmental Protection shall, within available appropriations and  
3 with the assistance of university-level interns who are majoring in a  
4 bioscience-related field, conduct a study on the feasibility or  
5 desirability on the use of bio-fuel, including plant residue, agricultural  
6 waste, native plants and animal waste, as a fuel source for home  
7 heating, boats, buses, trucks, construction machinery and electric  
8 generating plants, and report any findings, in accordance with section  
9 11-4a of the general statutes, to the joint standing committees of the  
10 General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to the  
11 environment and energy by January 1, 2006.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
