**AN ACT PROHIBITING SOIL MIXING AS A CONTAMINANT  
REMEDICATION METHOD ON CERTAIN PROPERTIES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That chapter 446k of the general statutes be amended to prohibit soil  
2 mixing as a contaminant remediation method on property that is to be  
3 used for residential purposes and is presently used for agricultural  
4 purposes or that has been used for agricultural purposes within the  
5 previous three years where such property is within an aquifer  
6 protection area, unless there is sufficient evidence for the Department  
7 of Environmental Protection to determine that the use of soil mixing  
8 will not endanger the water supply.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To provide that soil mixing may not be used to remediate contamination on land that is to be used for residential purposes.
