**AN ACT CONCERNING PAYMENTS IN LIEU OF TAXES FOR STATE-OWNED REAL PROPERTY AND MOTOR VEHICLES IN CERTAIN MUNICIPALITIES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That chapter 201 of the general statutes be amended to, for  
2 municipalities identified by the Office of Policy and Management  
3 under section 7-148dd of the general statutes, as having substantial  
4 economic disadvantages in relation to the other towns in the planning  
5 region, (1) increase the payments-in-lieu-of-taxes paid for state-owned  
6 property, and (2) provide for such payments for (A) motor vehicles  
7 owned by the state, and (B) property acquired and used for limited  
8 access highways.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To increase payments-in-lieu-of-taxes for certain state-owned property in towns having substantial economic disadvantages in relation to the other towns in the planning region.
