**AN ACT CONCERNING THE RECOVERY OF COMMISSIONS BY  
SALES REPRESENTATIVES IN CONNECTICUT.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1       That the general statutes be amended to provide that not later than  
2 thirty days after the termination of the business relationship between a  
3 sales representative located in this state and a principal, whether  
4 located in this state or out-of-state, the principal shall pay the sales  
5 representative all commissions that have become due as of the effective  
6 day of the termination and shall be liable in a civil action if such  
7 payment is not tendered.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To ensure that Connecticut sales representatives are able to recover the commissions due to them by both out-of-state and in-state principals.
