**AN ACT CONCERNING A STUDY OF THE FEASIBILITY OF USING A  
SOLE POWER SOURCE FOR METRO NORTH TRAINS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General  
Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require a study by the
- 2 Department of Transportation concerning funding of the feasibility of
- 3 implementing a sole power source for Metro North trains between
- 4 New York City and Connecticut.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To be able to purchase rail cars for Metro North at a lower cost than  
existing rail cars due to the fact that present rail cars require dual  
power sources as a result of different power platforms between New  
York City and Connecticut.
