**AN ACT CONCERNING THE OPERATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES  
UNDER BRIDGES OR OTHER STRUCTURES IN VIOLATION OF  
POSTED MINIMUM HEIGHT CLEARANCES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2005*) No person shall operate  
2 or move a motor vehicle over, on, through, or under any bridge or  
3 structure on any highway if the height of such vehicle or the load  
4 exceeds the height of the posted clearance or load, as shown by an  
5 official traffic control device, as defined in section 14-297 of the general  
6 statutes. Any person violating any provision of this section shall have  
7 committed an infraction.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

***Statement of Purpose:***

To make it an infraction to drive over or under a bridge in violation of posted height or weight limits.
