AN ACT CONCERNING THE SALARY OF FORMER TEACHERS RECEIVING BENEFITS FROM THE TEACHERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM WHO ARE TEMPORARILY REEMPLOYED TO TEACH IN TEACHER SHORTAGE AREAS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That subsection (a) of section 10-183v of the general statutes,
2 concerning the reemployment of former teachers receiving benefits
3 from the Teachers' Retirement System, be amended to allow retired
4 teachers to be temporarily employed by school districts in shortage
5 areas and to earn up to ninety per cent of the salary level for which the
6 individual is eligible by experience and degree for the assigned subject
7 area.

Statement of Purpose:

To address the teacher shortage and increase the salary of teachers reemployed in teacher shortage areas.
