AN ACT CONCERNING A STUDY OF THE EFFECTIVENESS OF TEEN ABSTINENCE PROGRAMS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 19a-125 of the general statutes be amended to require
- 2 the Adolescent Health Council to conduct a study regarding the
- 3 effectiveness of teen abstinence programs in preventing pregnancy,
- 4 sexually transmitted diseases and the onset of sexual activity and that
- 5 the council submit its findings to the General Assembly on or before
- 6 February 1, 2006.

Statement of Purpose:

To study the effectiveness of teen abstinence programs in preventing pregnancy, sexually transmitted diseases and the onset of sexual activity.
