**AN ACT CONCERNING GENDER SPECIFIC BEHAVIORAL HEALTH
AND ADDICTION SERVICES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to extend current statutory
- 2 requirements regarding juvenile offenders to other behavioral health
- 3 and addiction services programs delivered or funded by the state and
- 4 that a grant program be established by the Department of Children
- 5 and Families to encourage best practices in gender specific treatment.
