AN ACT CONCERNING THE EXCESS COST GRANT FOR SPECIAL EDUCATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That subsection (b) of section 10-76g of the general statutes be
- 2 amended to change the threshold which triggers state reimbursement
- 3 for locally placed special education students to three times the average
- 4 per pupil cost in each district.

Statement of Purpose:

To increase the state share of locally delivered special education services.
