***AN ACT CONCERNING DESIGNATION OF THE FARMINGTON RIVER
WITHIN THE NATIONAL WILD AND SCENIC RIVERS SYSTEM.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That section 25-178 of the general statutes be amended to provide
2 that the portion of the Farmington River which is the subject of the
3 authorized study by the Farmington Wild and Scenic River Study
4 Committee for purposes of designation as a national wild and scenic
5 rivers system be preserved as provided for in the federal Wild and
6 Scenic Rivers Act, Public Law 90-542, as amended, and that the
7 Commissioner of Environmental Protection cooperate with all relevant
8 federal, state and local agencies to provide for such designation and to
9 implement any management plan developed in accordance with the
10 Wild and Scenic Rivers Act.

Statement of Purpose:

To preserve the portion of the Farmington River which is the subject of the Farmington Wild and Scenic River Study Committee as provided for in the federal Wild and Scenic Rivers Act.
