**AN ACT AUTHORIZING BONDS OF THE STATE FOR THE
RENOVATION OF MARTIN HOUSE IN NORWICH FOR EFFICIENCY
UNITS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the State Bond Commission be empowered to authorize the
- 2 issuance of bonds of the state in accordance with section 3-20 of the
- 3 general statutes, in principal amounts not exceeding in the aggregate
- 4 eight hundred fifty thousand dollars, the proceeds of which shall be
- 5 used by the Department of Social Services for the purpose of
- 6 renovating the second floor of Martin House in Norwich to create
- 7 seventeen efficiency units.

Statement of Purpose:

To create seventeen efficiency units in Norwich.
