**AN ACT CONCERNING FEES PAID INTO THE ENVIRONMENTAL  
QUALITY FUND.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 22a-27j of the general statutes be amended to provide
- 2 that the fee charged for applications for approvals required by
- 3 chapters 124, 126, 440 and 444 of the general statutes remain at twenty
- 4 dollars for projects valued at twenty thousand dollars or more, and a
- 5 fee of ten dollars be imposed on projects valued at less than twenty
- 6 thousand dollars.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To provide that the fees levied upon applications for municipal planning, zoning, wetlands and coastal management be set at thirty dollars for projects valued at twenty thousand dollars and over and ten dollars for projects valued under twenty thousand dollars.
