**AN ACT CONCERNING A GRANT TO THE ASPINOCK HISTORICAL SOCIETY FOR THE RESTORATION AND RENOVATION OF CADY COPP COTTAGE IN PUTNAM.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (*Effective July 1, 2005*) The sum of one hundred thousand  
2 dollars is appropriated to the Department of Economic and  
3 Community Development, from the General Fund, for the fiscal year  
4 ending June 30, 2006, for a grant to the Aspinock Historical Society for  
5 the restoration and renovation of Cady Copp Cottage in Putnam.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
