AN ACT PROVIDING FREE TUITION AT STATE COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES FOR CHILDREN AND SPOUSES OF MILITARY PERSONNEL KILLED IN ACTION DURING OPERATION ENDURING FREEDOM, OPERATION NOBLE EAGLE OR OPERATION IRAQI FREEDOM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 185b of the general statutes be amended to waive the
- 2 payment of tuition fees at the Connecticut State University system, The
- 3 University of Connecticut and the regional community-technical
- 4 colleges for any dependent child or spouse of any person who served
- 5 in the armed forces and was killed in action during Operation
- 6 Enduring Freedom, Operation Noble Eagle or Operation Iraqi
- 7 Freedom.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide free tuition at all state colleges and universities for any dependent child or spouse of any person who served in the armed forces and was killed in action during Operation Enduring Freedom, Operation Noble Eagle or Operation Iraqi Freedom.
