AN ACT CONCERNING MOBILIZATION SERVICE AWARDS FOR MEMBERS OF THE CONNECTICUT NATIONAL GUARD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 27-73d of the general statutes is repealed and the
2 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from passage*):

3 The Adjutant General may issue an appropriate service ribbon to
4 members of the [Connecticut] National Guard or organized militia
5 who [had been] were called to active service in the armed forces of the
6 state or United States [under Title 10 of the United States Code] for at
7 least thirty consecutive days in support of [Operation Desert Shield or
8 Operation Desert Storm] any military operation commencing after
9 September 11, 2001, during a time of war, as defined in section 27-103.
10 A bronze service star shall be issued in lieu of succeeding awards and
11 a silver service star shall be worn in lieu of five bronze stars. The
12 ribbon may be awarded posthumously.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

To provide for service ribbons to members of the National Guard or organized militia who serve in any military operation after September 11, 2001, during a time of war.
