AN ACT CONCERNING THE DEFINITION OF LAKES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (*Effective July 1, 2005*) The joint standing committee of the
2 General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to planning
3 and development shall conduct a study of the definitions of bodies of
4 water, including, but not limited to, lakes, that may be used by local
5 zoning authorities in ordinances adopted under section 8-2 of the
6 general statutes. Not later than January 1, 2006, said committee shall
7 submit a report to the General Assembly on its findings and
8 recommendations.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
