**AN ACT CONCERNING PERSONNEL TEMPORARILY ASSIGNED TO
THE DEPARTMENT OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AND
HOMELAND SECURITY.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) (a) The Department of
2 Emergency Management and Homeland Security may request and
3 may receive from any federal, state or local agency, cooperation and
4 assistance in the performance of its duties, including the temporary
5 assignment of personnel necessary to carry out the performance of its
6 functions.

7 (b) Any such personnel temporarily assigned shall act under the
8 direction of the Commissioner of Emergency Management and
9 Homeland Security. The federal, state or local agency shall retain
10 administrative control over such personnel.

11 (c) For purposes of section 5-141d of the general statutes, such
12 personnel temporarily assigned shall be deemed to be acting as state
13 employees while assigned to, and performing the duties of, said
14 department.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Statement of Purpose:

To authorize the Department of Emergency Management and Homeland Security to request and receive assistance from any federal, state or local agency, including the temporary assignment of personnel; to specify the chain of command and administrative control of such personnel and to indemnify such personnel while assigned to and performing the duties of said department.
