AN ACT CONCERNING OUT OF SCHOOL TIME GRANTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2005*) (a) The Department of
2 Education, in consultation with the after school committee established
3 pursuant to section 10-16v of the general statutes, shall, within
4 available appropriations, administer a grant program to provide grants
5 for out of school time programs to local and regional boards of
6 education, municipalities and not-for-profit organizations that are
7 exempt from taxation under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue
8 Code of 1986, or any subsequent corresponding internal revenue code
9 of the United States, as from time to time amended. For purposes of
10 this subsection, "out of school time program" means a program that
11 takes place when school is not in session and is for the enrichment and
12 education of children in grades kindergarten to twelve, inclusive.

13 (b) Applications for grants pursuant to subsection (a) of this section
14 shall be filed annually with the Commissioner of Education at such
15 time and in such manner as the commissioner prescribes.

16 (c) For purposes of carrying out the provisions of subsections (a)
17 and (b) of this section, the Department of Education may accept funds
18 from private sources and from any state agency that is a member of the
19 after school committee.

20 Sec. 2. (*Effective July 1, 2005*) The sum of five million dollars is
21 appropriated to the Department of Education, from the General Fund,
22 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2006, for the purposes of section 1 of
23 this act.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
