AN ACT CONCERNING LIQUOR LICENSE PERMITTEES AND PUB CRAWLS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) (a) No person who holds a
2 permit to sell alcoholic liquor, as defined in section 30-1 of the general
3 statutes, shall knowingly allow such permitted premises to be used to
4 host a pub crawl. For purposes of this section, "pub crawl" means an
5 organized event intended to promote the organized travel of
6 individuals between licensed premises for the purpose of consuming
7 alcoholic liquor at more than one premise.

8 (b) Any person who violates the provisions of subsection (a) of this
9 section shall be subject to the penalties described in section 30-113 of
10 the general statutes.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
