AN ACT CONCERNING CONTRACTORS DOING WORK IN SCHOOLS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2005*) Each local and regional
2 board of education shall require any person entering into a contract to
3 perform maintenance, repair, construction or landscaping work at any
4 school or on the grounds of any school or any employee of the
5 contractor or subcontractor performing such work to submit to state
6 and national criminal history records checks conducted in accordance
7 with section 29-17a of the general statutes. The contractor,
8 subcontractor or their employees shall submit to such check no later
9 than fifteen days from the date such contractor or subcontractor enters
10 into such contract and prior to the performance of work under the
11 contract. Any finding of a criminal conviction of a contractor or
12 subcontractor or of their employees or refusal to submit to the criminal
13 history records checks may result in termination of the contract.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
