**AN ACT CONCERNING APPROPRIATIONS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES FOR ALZHEIMER'S RESPITE CARE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective July 1, 2005*) (a) The sum of three million dollars  
2 is appropriated to the Department of Social Services, from the General  
3 Fund, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2006, for Alzheimer's Respite  
4 Care.

5 (b) The sum of three million dollars is appropriated to the  
6 Department of Social Services, from the General Fund, for the fiscal  
7 year ending June 30, 2007, for Alzheimer's Respite Care.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

**Statement of Purpose:**

To increase the level of appropriations recommended by the Governor for the Alzheimer Respite Care program from one million two hundred twenty thousand two hundred dollars to three million dollars for each of the next two fiscal years.
