AN ACT CONCERNING A PILOT PROGRAM THAT INCLUDES SERVICES PROVIDED BY SCHOOL-BASED HEALTH CENTERS AND FAMILY RESOURCE CENTERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2005*) The Commissioner of
2 Education, in conjunction with the Commissioner of Public Health,
3 shall establish a pilot program for a period of two years that authorizes
4 up to four schools to combine the services of school-based health
5 centers and family resource centers. Local and regional boards of
6 education interested in participating in the pilot program shall apply
7 to the department at such time and in such a manner as the
8 Commissioner of Education prescribes. Participants accepted to the
9 program shall be given a grant of two hundred thousand dollars for
10 each fiscal year of the program.

11 Sec. 2. (*Effective July 1, 2005*) (a) The sum of eight hundred thousand
12 dollars is appropriated to the Department of Education, from the
13 General Fund, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2006, for the purpose
14 of the competitive grant program pursuant to section 1 of this act.

15 (b) The sum of eight hundred thousand dollars is appropriated to
16 the Department of Education, from the General Fund, for the fiscal
17 year ending June 30, 2007, for the purpose of the competitive grant
18 program pursuant to section 1 of this act.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
