***AN ACT REQUIRING A COST-BENEFIT ANALYSIS OF HEALTH INSURANCE BENEFITS MANDATED IN THIS STATE.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the Insurance Commissioner be required to (1) conduct a cost-
- 2 benefit analysis of all benefits required to be provided by health
- 3 insurers pursuant to chapter 700c of the general statutes, and (2)
- 4 submit a report on such analysis to the General Assembly.

***Statement of Purpose:***

To require the Insurance Commissioner to conduct a cost-benefit analysis of health insurance benefits mandated in this state.
