AN ACT PROMOTING VOTING SYSTEM ACCURACY, INTEGRITY AND SECURITY THROUGH VOTER-VERIFIED PERMANENT PAPER RECORDS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 9-242 of the general statutes be amended to require that
- 2 any voting machine approved by the Secretary of the State for an
- 3 election or primary to be held on or after January 1, 2006, be so
- 4 constructed as to produce an individual, permanent, voter-verified
- 5 paper record for each elector casting a vote on the machine.

To improve the integrity and security of Connecticut's electoral process.
