AN ACT CONCERNING A STUDY OF COMPREHENSIVE CAMPAIGN FINANCE REFORM FOR STATE-WIDE CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (*Effective July 1, 2005*) The joint standing committee of the
2 General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to elections
3 shall study comprehensive campaign finance reform for state-wide
4 constitutional offices. Not later than January 1, 2006, said committee
5 shall submit a report to the General Assembly, in accordance with the
6 provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes, on its findings and
7 recommendations.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
