AN ACT CONCERNING PRESCRIPTION DRUG LABELS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 370 of the general statutes be amended to require all
- 2 licensed pharmacists dispensing prescriptions and all health care
- 3 institutions or facility pharmacies to include on each prescription label,
- 4 at the request of the patient, information about the purpose for which
- 5 the drug is being prescribed.

Statement of Purpose:

To ensure that information about the purpose of a prescription drug is readily available to any patient who is prescribed the drug and requests such information.
