AN ACT CONCERNING THE APPROVAL OF FAST TRACK CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subsection (i) of section 4b-91 of the general statutes is
2 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from*
3 *passage*):

4 (i) [In the event that the] The General Assembly [approves] shall not
5 approve legislation authorizing an exception to the competitive
6 bidding process for a project, unless such legislation is approved by a
7 two-thirds vote of the members of each house of the General
8 Assembly. In the event that the General Assembly approves legislation
9 authorizing an exception to the competitive bidding process for a
10 project, the State Properties Review Board shall complete a review of
11 the contract for such project and approve or disapprove such contract
12 no later than thirty days after the Commissioner of Public Works
13 submits such contract to the board. Such review shall be conducted in
14 accordance with the provisions of section 4b-3. In the event that such
15 review does not occur within the thirty-day period prescribed by this

16 subsection, such contract shall be deemed to be approved.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:		
Section 1	<i>from passage</i>	4b-91(i)

Statement of Purpose:

To require fast track construction projects to be approved by a two-thirds vote of the members of each house of the General Assembly.
