**AN ACT CONCERNING THE AUTHORITY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF
CONSUMER PROTECTION TO INVESTIGATE MISCONDUCT BY
HOME IMPROVEMENT AND NEW HOME CONSTRUCTION
CONTRACTORS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapters 399a and 400 of the general statutes be amended to
- 2 provide the Department of Consumer Protection with the authority to
- 3 investigate all allegations of misconduct by home improvement and
- 4 new home construction contractors.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow for state investigation of home improvement and new home construction contractors without requiring a pattern of repeat violations.
