**AN ACT CONCERNING THE MOTOR BOAT FUEL TAX AND THE
CONSERVATION FUND.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That chapter 221 of the general statutes be amended to provide that
2 three million five hundred thousand dollars received by the state
3 related to the sale of motor boat fuel be credited to the Conservation
4 Fund established under section 22a-27h of the general statutes, and be
5 used to fund fisheries and boating programs of the Department of
6 Environmental Protection.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide a secure funding source for Department of Environmental Protection programs that generate motor boat fuel tax revenue.
