**AN ACT CONCERNING EMPLOYER COMMUNICATIONS ABOUT
POLITICS, RELIGION OR LABOR ORGANIZING ACTIVITIES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to prohibit any employer from
- 2 coercing employees into attending or participating in any
- 3 communications by the employer that express said employer's
- 4 opinions about politics, religion or labor organizing activities.

Statement of Purpose:

To prohibit an employer from coercing employees into attending or participating in communications by the employer about the employer's views on politics, religion or labor organizing activities.
