AN ACT CONCERNING PAID LEAVE FOR VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTER TRAINING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 31 of the general statutes be amended to require that
- 2 employers of more than one hundred employees allow at least eight
- 3 hours of unpaid leave annually for volunteer firefighters to receive
- 4 training.

Statement of Purpose:

To require that employers of more than one hundred employees allow at least eight hours of paid leave annually for volunteer firefighters to receive training.
