**AN ACT AUTHORIZING BONDS OF THE STATE FOR THE  
PRESERVATION AND RENOVATION OF THE ELI WHITNEY  
MUSEUM'S HOMESTEAD BOARDING HOUSE FOR MEN IN HAMDEN.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the State Bond Commission be empowered to authorize the
- 2 issuance of bonds of the state in accordance with section 3-20 of the
- 3 general statutes, in principal amounts not exceeding in the aggregate
- 4 four hundred fifty thousand dollars, the proceeds of which shall be
- 5 used by the Department of Economic and Community Development
- 6 for the purpose of a grant to the Eli Whitney Museum for the historic
- 7 preservation and rehabilitation of said museum's Homestead Boarding
- 8 House for Men in Hamden.
