**AN ACT PROHIBITING THE SALE, RESALE, LEASE OR USE OF
RECALLED CHILDREN'S PRODUCTS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 21a-336 of the general statutes is repealed and the
2 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from passage*):

3 (a) Whenever in the judgment of the administrator such action will
4 promote the objectives of sections 21a-335 to 21a-346, inclusive, by
5 avoiding or resolving uncertainty as to application, the administrator
6 may, by regulation, declare to be a hazardous substance, for the
7 purposes of said sections, any substance or mixture of substances
8 which he finds meets the requirements of subdivision (1) of subsection
9 (e) of section 21a-335.

10 (b) The administrator may, in addition to regulations adopted under
11 subsection (a) of this section, promulgate regulations establishing
12 safety requirements, safety standards, banned hazardous substances,
13 labeling requirements and testing procedures for articles subject to
14 sections 21a-335 to 21a-346, inclusive.

15 (c) If the administrator finds that the hazard of an article subject to
16 sections 21a-335 to 21a-346, inclusive, is such that labeling adequate to
17 protect the public health and safety cannot be devised, or the article
18 presents an imminent danger to the public health and safety, the
19 administrator may by regulation declare such article to be a banned
20 hazardous substance and require its removal from commerce. The
21 administrator may compile, and from time to time amend, a list of toys
22 and other articles which are intended for use by children and which
23 are classified as banned hazardous substances.

24 (d) The administrator shall adopt regulations, in accordance with
25 chapter 54, as the administrator deems necessary to prevent the sale,
26 resale or lease of any toy or article intended for use by children that is
27 the subject of a recall by the federal Consumer Product Safety
28 Commission. Such regulations shall include, but are not limited to,
29 required procedures and measures necessary to prevent the use of any
30 such toy or article in a licensed child care facility.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
