**AN ACT PROHIBITING THE USE OF CELLULAR TELEPHONES
WHILE PUMPING GASOLINE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to prohibit a person using a
- 2 cellular telephone while pumping gasoline at a gasoline station and to
- 3 provide that any person who violates that prohibition shall be fined
- 4 two hundred fifty dollars.

Statement of Purpose:

To make it illegal to use a cellular telephone while pumping gasoline.
