AN ACT CONCERNING A COMMON UNIT OF ENERGY MEASUREMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require an electric
- 2 distribution company, gas company, or a registered seller of petroleum
- 3 products, to provide its customers, upon request, information
- 4 regarding the conversion of their respective product from kilowatt
- 5 hours, therms or gallons, as applicable, to British thermal units.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide consumers with a common unit measurement to facilitate the comparison of energy sources.
