**AN ACT APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR THE PEQUONOCK RIVER
RAILS TO TRAILS PROGRAM IN MONROE, TRUMBULL AND
BRIDGEPORT.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) The sum of two hundred thousand
2 dollars is appropriated to the Department of Environmental
3 Protection, from the General Fund, for the fiscal year ending June 30,
4 2006, for completion of the Pequonock River Rails to Trails program in
5 Monroe, Trumbull and Bridgeport.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
