**AN ACT AUTHORIZING BONDS OF THE STATE FOR THE INSTITUTE
FOR THE HISPANIC FAMILY IN HARTFORD.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the State Bond Commission be empowered to authorize the
- 2 issuance of bonds of the state in accordance with section 3-20 of the
- 3 general statutes, in principal amounts not exceeding in the aggregate
- 4 two million dollars, the proceeds of which shall be used by the
- 5 Department of Social Services for the purpose of assisting the Institute
- 6 for the Hispanic Family in Hartford to relocate and expand program
- 7 capacity.

Statement of Purpose:

To permit the State Bond Commission to issue bonds that shall be used to assist the Institute for the Hispanic Family to relocate and expand program capacity.
