**AN ACT CONCERNING BY-PRODUCT, SOURCE, SPECIAL NUCLEAR MATERIALS AND OTHER SOURCES OF IONIZING RADIATION.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to allow the Commissioner of
- 2 Environmental Protection to adopt regulations, in accordance with the
- 3 provisions of chapter 54 of the general statutes, for the general or
- 4 specific licensing of by-product, source, special nuclear materials and
- 5 other sources of ionizing radiation or devices or equipment utilizing
- 6 such materials. The commissioner may issue, deny, renew, modify,
- 7 suspend or revoke such licenses and may include such terms and
- 8 conditions in such licenses that the commissioner deems necessary.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To authorize the Governor to enter into an agreement with the United States Nuclear Regulatory Commission for the delegation to the state of certain Nuclear Regulatory Commission programs to enhance the control and security of radioactive materials.
