AN ACT ESTABLISHING A MILITARY FAMILY RELIEF FUND.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That a Military Family Relief Fund be established in the state and be
- 2 based on a program established by the state of Illinois. Said fund
- 3 would supplement the income of the families of citizen soldiers and
- 4 could also assist in making the homes of soldiers injured in the line of
- 5 duty and disabled accessible upon returning home. It is further
- 6 proposed that the Military Family Relief Fund be supported by a
- 7 voluntary check-off box allowing taxpayers to contribute to the fund
- 8 from their income tax return.

Statement of Purpose:

To establish a Military Family Relief Fund in the state allowing taxpayers to contribute to said fund from their income tax return through a check-off box.
