**AN ACT CONCERNING FEDERALLY QUALIFIED HEALTH CENTERS
AND LOOK ALIKE COMMUNITY HEALTH CENTERS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to provide that the
- 2 Department of Social Services shall be permitted to contract with the
- 3 Community Health and Wellness Center of Torrington, and any other
- 4 similarly situated entity that has received designation as either a
- 5 federally qualified health center or a federally qualified health center
- 6 look alike, for the provision of medical services to individuals enrolled
- 7 in any medical program administered by the department.

Statement of Purpose:

To clarify the eligibility of the Community Health and Wellness Center of Greater Torrington and other similarly situated facilities to participate in programs administered by the Department of Social Services.
