AN ACT ESTABLISHING MEDICAL MALPRACTICE INSURANCE REFORMS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to: (1) Require medical
- 2 malpractice settlements and related information to be reported to the
- 3 Insurance Commissioner; (2) require the Department of Public Health
- 4 to report to the Governor and the General Assembly the number and
- 5 nature of petitions filed against physicians; (3) require the collection of
- 6 certain data from physicians at the time of licensure in this state; (4)
- 7 require the Insurance Department to collect data on each medical
- 8 malpractice claim; and (5) require captive insurers that do business in
- 9 this state to register with the Insurance Department.

Statement of Purpose:

To obtain additional information about physician licensure, medical malpractice settlements, claims payments and captive insurers by requiring reports to and from the Insurance Department and the Department of Public Health.
