AN ACT REQUIRING THE VIDEOTAPING OF CUSTODIAL INTERROGATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the general statutes be amended to provide that any
2 interrogation of, and any oral admission, confession or statement
3 obtained from, a person under investigation for or accused of a capital
4 felony or class A or B felony during custodial interrogation at a police
5 station, courthouse, correctional facility, community correctional
6 center or detention facility shall be electronically recorded in its
7 entirety by use of an electronic audiovisual device.

Statement of Purpose:

To require the videotaping of custodial interrogations of persons under investigation for or accused of the commission of a capital felony or a class A or B felony.
