AN ACT CONCERNING BONDING FOR FARMLAND PRESERVATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the State Bond Commission be empowered to authorize the
- 2 issuance of bonds of the state, in each of the next five fiscal years, in
- 3 accordance with section 3-20 of the general statutes, in principal
- 4 amounts not exceeding in the aggregate ten million dollars, the
- 5 proceeds of which shall be used by the Department of Agriculture for
- 6 the purpose of farmland preservation.

Statement of Purpose:

To authorize the issuance of bonds of the state for farmland preservation.
