AN ACT ESTABLISHING FREDERICK LAW OLMSTED DAY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 10-29a of the general statutes be amended to provide
- 2 that the Governor shall proclaim April twenty-sixth of each year to be
- 3 "Frederick Law Olmsted Day" in honor of the great legacy that this
- 4 native son of the state created including being the founder of American
- 5 landscape architecture.

Statement of Purpose:

To honor Frederick Law Olmsted.
