AN ACT ESTABLISHING FREDERICK LAW OLMSTED DAY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 10-29a of the general statutes is amended by
2 adding subdivision (49) as follows (*Effective October 1, 2005*):

3 (NEW) (49) The Governor shall proclaim April twenty-sixth of each
4 year to be "Frederick Law Olmsted Day" to honor his legacy as the
5 founder of American landscape architecture. Suitable exercises shall be
6 held in the State Capitol and elsewhere as the Governor designates for
7 the observance of the day.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
