**AN ACT PROHIBITING LAW ENFORCEMENT ACCESS TO
RECORDED INFORMATION IN "BLACK BOXES" IN MOTOR
VEHICLES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to prohibit law enforcement
- 2 personnel from access to data, except by warrant or with consent of the
- 3 owner of the motor vehicle, collected in electronic devices (black
- 4 boxes) installed by manufacturers in motor vehicles, which devices
- 5 collect information about matters such a speed, braking and skidding
- 6 during the seconds that precede a serious collision.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide for privacy protection for motorists.
