**AN ACT CONCERNING THE REVITALIZATION OF STATE-OWNED  
MODERATE INCOME PUBLIC HOUSING DEVELOPMENTS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to establish a process for the
- 2 revitalization of state-owned moderate income public housing
- 3 developments, require a relocation plan for displaced tenants and
- 4 require the one-for-one replacement of housing units for low income
- 5 tenants.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To revitalize state-owned moderate income public housing developments into self-sustaining, thriving and economically stable communities.
