**AN ACT REQUIRING CRIMINAL BACKGROUND CHECKS FOR  
HEALTH CARE AND HOME CARE WORKERS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require health care workers
- 2 and home care workers to submit to state and national criminal history
- 3 records checks conducted in accordance with section 29-17a of the
- 4 general statutes as a condition of employment.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To help protect patients and clients of health care agencies and home care agencies from abuse by requiring criminal background checks for health care and home care workers.
